**CHAPTER:** FIVE – PROVIDER NETWORK & CONTRACT MANAGEMENT  
**POLICY #:** 05-01-018

**PURPOSE**

To promote the coordination of physical health and behavioral health care for those with co-morbid conditions.

**APPLICATION**

Priority need populations as agreed to with Medicaid Health Plans.

**POLICY**

It is the policy of the Northern Michigan Regional Entity, as the Prepaid Inpatient Health Plan responsible for services to individuals enrolled in Medicaid, to coordinate care provided to individuals with the Medicaid Health Plan also managing services for those individuals. It is further the policy of the Northern Michigan Regional Entity to work cooperatively with other MHP to jointly identify priority need populations for purposes of care coordination. In support of this policy, the Northern Michigan Regional Entity shall work to secure appropriate consents, share necessary electronic data, and conduct routine care coordination activities necessary to fulfill this policy.

In furtherance of this policy, the NMRE shall:

- a. At least monthly, identify which members are assigned to an MHP and have sought services through the PIHP
- b. Receive information from electronic sources
- c. Participate in MiHIN as appropriate for care coordination.
