CHAPTER: SEVEN – MEMBER SERVICES
POLICY #: 07-01-003
EFFECTIVE DATE: January 1, 2014

PURPOSE

To establish policy and expectation regarding collaborative care inclusive of behavioral health, substance use disorder, and primary health care services.

APPLICATION

All providers on the NMRE provider panel.

POLICY

It is the policy of the Northern Michigan Regional Entity (NMRE) that services are delivered in a coordinated manner. To the extent possible, person-centered services are to be planned, delivered, and monitored in collaboration with other healthcare providers serving an individual, including, but not limited to: primary care practitioners, substance use disorder service providers, and appropriate social service entities. Collaboration will be recovery based, culturally competent, and trauma informed.

The NMRE Provider Network will establish relationships, as appropriate, with the various healthcare providers within the community, in order to promote collaboration and coordination of care. Each NMRE provider will request that persons served sign the necessary consents needed to facilitate this collaboration.
