PURPOSE

The purpose of the policy is to identify goals pursuant to Section IV of the Northern Michigan Regional Entity Board Governance Policy. Goal statements will be reviewed and/or revised annually.

APPLICATION

This policy applies to the NMRE Board of Directors, NMRE staff, the five Member Community Mental Health Services Programs (CMHSPs), and the NMRE Substance Use Disorder Services provider panel.

POLICY

1. The NMRE will improve the wellness of persons served through identifying and addressing health disparities in the population.
2. The NMRE is 100% compliant with the provisions of the contract(s) it holds with MDCH.
3. The NMRE will have a uniform benefit with the distribution of resources in a manner that supports parity in the availability of services across the region.
4. The NMRE will support and encourage the implementation and use of evidence-based practices and promising practices.
5. The NMRE will provide regional leadership regarding integrated healthcare.
6. The NMRE will be an effective link (communication, advocacy, compliance) between the MDCH and the CMHSPs.
7. The NMRE will not increase managed care administrative costs beyond historic costs. Appropriate long-term goals will be established in order to not reduce funding to services.
