**CHAPTER:** SEVEN – MEMBER SERVICES

**PURPOSE**

To assure the consistent delivery of person-centered services across the service delivery system. To this end, the Northern Michigan Regional Entity (NMRE) has formally adopted the MDHHS Person-Centered Planning Revised Practice Guideline (March 15, 2011).

**APPLICATION**

This policy applies to the five Member Community Mental Health Services Programs (CMHSPs), and the NMRE Substance Use Disorder Services provider panel.

**POLICY**

It is the policy of the NMRE that services be provided in accordance with an individual plan of services developed through a person-centered process. The specific requirements of person-centered planning processes are found in the NMRE *Person-Centered Planning Protocols and Guidelines*.
