PURPOSE

To establish a policy for screening for Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD).

APPLICATION

This policy shall apply to all providers on the Northern Michigan Regional Entity (NMRE) Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Services Provider Panel.

POLICY

It is the policy of NMRE that all SUD providers on the NMRE Substance Use Disorder Services Provider Panel include FASD prevention within their treatment regimen as indicated in the MDHHS Office of Recovery Oriented Systems of Care (OROSOC) Substance Abuse Treatment Policy #11 – Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders. For any SUD Service Providers having contact with children born to women who have used alcohol the provider must screen these children for FASD as in compliance with MDHHS/OROSOC Substance Abuse Treatment Policy #11 – Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders, and refer for further diagnostic services as indicated.
