INFORMATIONAL REPORTS

**Admissions**

The admissions report through May 31, 2021 was included in the materials for the meeting on this date. Overall admissions were up 9.37% from FY20. The data showed that males made up most of the individuals served at 61.59%, outpatient was the highest level of treatment at 55.07%, and alcohol was the most prevalent primary substance at 48.06% (heroin was second at 16.93%). Sara Sircely noted that methamphetamine use is rising throughout the region reported as 12.81% vs. 8.93% in FY20.

**Finance**

April Monthly Report

SUD services through April 30, 2021 showed all funding source revenue of \$11,815,513 and \$9,847,949 in expenses, resulting in a net surplus of \$1,968,473. Total PA2 funds were reported as \$6,211,731.

## Liquor Tax Application Redesign

- Application  
Ms. Sircely explained that the liquor tax application was reworked in an attempt to obtain all necessary information. The application focuses the use of PA2 for substance use prevention, treatment, and recovery efforts.
- Fringe Limit  
Amounts greater than 25% will require justification.
- Indirect Cost Limits  
Amounts greater than 10% will require justification.

Feedback was requested regarding the proposed changes. The fringe and indirect cost limits will be presented to the NMRE Board for approval during its next meeting on July 28, 2021.

## RECOMMENDATION ITEMS

### **PA2 Fund Balance Limits**

A handout showing PA2 activity was distributed to the NMRE SUD Oversight Board (and emailed to virtual attendees) on this date. A reserve balance of two years' receipts per county was proposed (approximately \$3M total). A policy recommendation will be drafted for approval by the NMRE Board. Ms. Brummund asked whether interest earned on the balances will it be provided back to the counties. Ms. Yockey responded that it would require a policy change. Mr. Kurtz agreed to bring the matter to the NMRE Board for discussion. Mr. Draves suggested informing the counties' Boards of Commissioners of the recommendation; Mr. Frye agreed.
